# 1 Register on Oxford Learn

You only need one account for all of your courses

To register an account:

1. Go to [www.oxfordlearn.com](http://www.oxfordlearn.com)



2. Click **Create your Oxford ID**. There are three parts to the form:
  - Personal details
  - Security information
  - Terms and Conditions

3. Enter your personal details.  
Your **Username** is your email address.

4. Choose a **Password**.  
Your password must be at least 6 characters long, with no spaces. It must include:
  - At least one lower-case letter (a to z)
  - At least one upper-case letter (A to Z)

Your password must be a minimum of 6 characters and include at least one lower case letter and one upper case letter, with no spaces.

Confirm password:

6. Choose your **Country** from the drop-down list.
7. Your **Security information** helps to protect your account:
  - Choose a **Security question** from the drop-down list.
  - Type the answer to the question into the box below it.

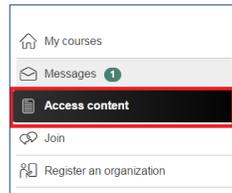
- In your book
